**Position Title:** Gimaajii Gym Activities Coordinator

The Gimaajii Gym Activities Coordinator supervises and coordinates physical activities, games, and well-being activities with children and youth who reside in permanent supportive housing (PSH), emergency shelter, and/or other AICHO program participants. The Coordinator will build strong relationships with children and families, ensure a safe environment, promote healthy child development and cultural connections, and help build a safe community setting. This position requires mandated reporting and training will be available upon hire. This position reports to the Gimaajii-Mino-Bimaadizimin Director.

**Wages/Salary:** \$18-\$20/hr

**Status:** Part-time, non-exempt (16-24 hours a week)

**Benefits:** paid holidays, short-term disability, paid time off (PTO)

#### **Position duties include-**

- Coordinate and supervise gym and well-being activities for children and youth
- Incorporate cultural activities whenever possible
- Provide light snacks and beverages as needed
- Post tentative schedule of activities and communicate with shelter and PSH program staff
- Ensure a safe setting and environment
- Build strong relationships with AICHO program staff, AICHO families and children/youth
- Report/communicate any concerns with children or youth to Gimaajii Director and work in a team approach to address any issues

#### **Qualifications:**

- Commitment to healthy Indigenous community and cultural knowledge
- Experience working with children/youth and families
- Experience working in culturally-based and community-based strategies
- Education or equivalent experience relevant to position
- Ability to communicate (verbal, written) in a variety of settings, formats, and audience sizes
- Ability to work effectively independently and within team(s)
